Lift-accessed mountain biking will follow, starting July 1. Fourth of July celebrations will fill the week from July 1-7, including free yoga and live music at River Run, a pickleball tournament, ballet at the Sun Valley Pavillion, a special concert featuring Marcus King & Tylor and The Train Robbers, fireworks, Sun Valley On Ice, and more.

July 1 marks Bald Mountain’s opening day for lift-accessed mountain biking and which will kick off with a free one-hour class held at River Run Plaza, presented by Brass Ranch. Marcus King & Tylor and The Train Robbers presented by Sun Valley and RJK Entertainment will headline on July 4 from 6:30-10PM at the Pavillion, followed by fireworks to create a night to remember. The golf season will commence on Saturday May 20, with the opening of White Clouds and the back nine holes of the 7,214 yard-long Elkhorn Golf course. The front nine of Elkhorn and the 6,986-yard Trail Creek championship course will open later this spring.
